




Overview

Exit the event by closing the browser window







Schedule and Staging



Construction work is scheduled to begin on May 22 and is estimated to be substantially completed with new pavement in Mid- November.

Please note that schedules are subject to change due to:

- Weather
- Unforeseen circumstances
- Underground surprises

The project will be completed in two Stages

Stage I	Stage II
Johnson to Stinson	Johnson to Central
- Phase 1 North side	- Phase 1 North side
- Phase 2 South side	- Phase 2 South side


In Stage 1: Phase 1 all through traffic will be closed on 37th avenue between Johnson St. and Stinson Blvd. One way east bound local traffic will be allowed for local access.

In Stage 1 Phase 2 all through traffic will be closed on 37th avenue between Johnson St. and Stinson Blvd. One way west bound local traffic will be allowed.


Detour Route

37th Ave NE












Detour Route

Hours of Operation

Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

City water work -

- There will be a temporary water shutoffs.
- Prior notice will be sent out where there will be a temporary water shot off.
- We will notify for an 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. shut off the day prior to doing the shut off.
- The process for notification is to hang a notice on the front door knob on the houses.





Traffic Control





The majority of the work will be done under traffic, so local access to residents will be maintained.

When we replace your driveway, we will notify you in advance and ask you to park at another location for 8 days to allow the concrete to properly cure.



What are they?

They improve the quality of stormwater that runs off hard surfaces


designed for managing stormwater runoff


