SUMMARY OF BASIS FOR DECISION

This memo summarizes my approach and reasoning for my decision as Chief of the Minneapolis Police Department to Suspend Officer Maisano for 20 Hours. This memo accompanies the enclosed MPD Worksheet.

Policies Violated:

MPD 3-204 Duty Handguns

MPD 5-406 Approval of Firearms

Facts Supporting Decision (see also Investigation Summary):

On January 13, 2020 at 2300 hours, Officer Anthony Maisano reported to the Minneapolis Police Department's Firearm Range for the annual handgun qualification. Maisano was on the MPD range and in a shooting booth as the qualification started. Almost immediately, Maisano's duty handgun failed to fire. Officer Maisano attempted to self-correct his firearm's malfunctions. Range Staff assigned that night observed Maisano's handgun malfunctions and attempted to assist.

Facts of this Case:

- Maisano attempted to qualify during the 2020 annual MPD handgun qualification. His declared duty handgun and magazines suffered multiple malfunctions.
- Range staff realized that Maisano' handgun had an aftermarket trigger and took possession of it.
 Maisano was issued a loaner handgun and three magazines.
- conducted an inspection of Maisano's declared duty handgun. He
 identified six issues with the weapon system, which included, an aftermarket trigger that had
 been installed incorrectly. Maisano's added magazine extensions caused misfeeds.
- Maisano admitted that he installed the aftermarket parts that were identified on his handgun and magazines.
- Maisano is not a certified armorer for his declared handgun: Smith and Wesson M&P 2.0 9mm.
- Maisano stated that the alterations he made to his firearm had put himself and others in danger during the prior patrol shifts he had worked in the Fourth Precinct.

As Chief of Police I am responsible for providing clear expectations on what is acceptable behavior in our workplaces. All employees are responsible for making themselves aware of and knowledgeable regarding MPD Policies and Procedures. While Officer Maisano based on the facts of this case committed a clear violation of policy he fully acknowledged his mistake and took ownership and accountability for his actions. It is my decision that Officer Maisano serve a 20 Hour Suspension for violating our department's Duty Handguns policy and receive Coaching for MPD Policy 5-406 Approval of Firearms.
