

## Project Background

- Reconstruction of 4th Street, 2nd Avenue North to 4th Street Avenue South
- Building face to building face





## Project Scope

- Replace the aging street infrastructure including existing street, curb and gutter, driveways, and sidewalk
- New protected bike facility (i.e., twoway off street)
- Better sidewalks and pedestrian crossings
- Remove existing contraflow bus lane and relocate bus service to 3<sup>rd</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Street
- New planting beds and street trees








## **Project Schedule**

 2021








## **Utility Construction**

- Xcel Energy manhole expansion and duct facility upgrades
  - East of Hennepin Ave (Summer 2020 Fall 2021)
  - West of Hennepin Ave (Spring 2021 Fall 2021)
- Telecommunication utility relocations
  - Summer 2020 Fall 2020










## **Roadway Construction**

- 4th Street closed to through traffic once construction begins
- Vehicle and bus detours
- Local access maintained via cross streets
















### 4th Street Detour







## What to Expect During Construction

- Noise, vibration, and dust in work areas
- Lane and parking restrictions
- Through traffic maintained during utility work
- Pedestrian and bicycle detours
- Regular meetings with project staff and weekly email updates

**UPCOMING EVENTS** 

A virtual pre-assessment meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 27, from 4-5 p.m. to discuss project updates and assessment process. Visit the project website for more information on the pre-assessment meeting.

A public hearing for the project will be held during the Transportation and Public Works committee of the Minneapolis City Council on Wednesday, November 4th at 1:30 PM.

#### WHAT IS HAPPENING

- This week, Xcel Energy continues with utility work on 4th St. between Nicollet Mall and 2nd Ave S. Expect lane reductions along 4th St. as work occurs throughout the week.
- Restoration work at City Hall continues. Expect lane reduction on 4th St. to facilitate this work.
- Private telecommunication work continues at the 4th St. and 3rd Ave. intersection and requires periodic lane closure in the intersection.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Lane reductions will occur as utility work moves along the corridor. Pedestrian access will be maintained on at least one side of the street.
- Expect additional noise, dust, and vibration as crews complete work.
- Look for biweekly project updates through 2020 and weekly updates beginning in spring 2021.



## **Corridor Layout**




Existing cross section on 4th St between 2nd Ave and 3rd Ave

- Narrow pavement from 54' to 33'
- Maintain three eastbound travel lanes on the corridor
- Add two-way off-street bike facility

- Increase sidewalk space for pedestrian
- Remove contraflow bus lane
































## Streetscape

- Add streetscaping/landscaping elements such as trees and planters
- Improve the pedestrian realm by widening sidewalks







# Project Cost and Assessment

- The total estimated project cost is \$17,302,832.
- The project is funded as follow:
  - \$10,711,000 in local funds
  - \$5,960,000 in Municipal State Aid
  - \$631,832 in Street Assessment Bond
