


#### 2013 Minneapolis Climate Action Plan





#### **ACCESS MINNEAPOLIS Ten Year Transportation Action Plan**

The purpose of Access Minneapolis is to identify specific actions that the City and its partner agencies (Metro Transit, Metropolitan Council, Hennepin County, Minnesota Department of Transportation) need to take within the next ten years to implement the transportation policies articulated in Minneapolis' Comprehensive Plan.










