

Safe Routes to School

Green Central Elementary

Project Background

The Green Central Safe Routes to School (SRTS) project will build pedestrian and bicycle improvements on E 34th Street and 10th or 11th Avenues in 2024. This project will build a safe connection to Green Central Elementary School, other bikeways, parks, and important destinations in the area.

To collect additional feedback from residents in the area, the project team provided an online survey which was open from June 8th - July 29th 2022. The results and key themes received are shown below.

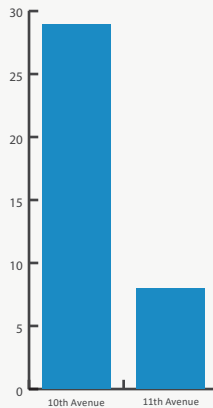

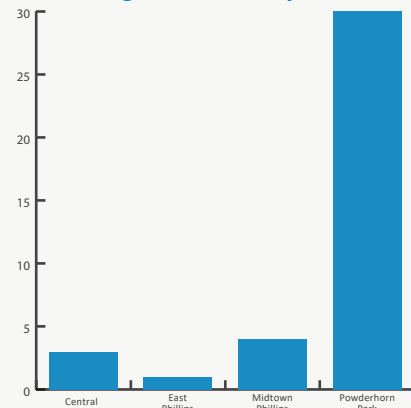
Survey Responses

We are proposing a bikeway connection on 34th Street and either 10th or 11th Avenues. Tell us which alignment

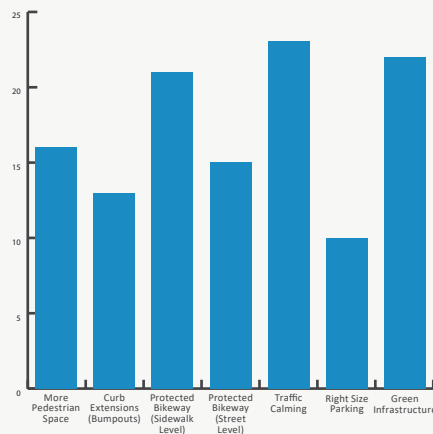
(10th or 11th Avenues) you prefer.



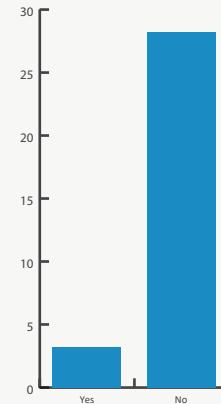
What Neighborhood do you Live in?

Survey Response Themes

- Overall excitement for improved walking and biking infrastructure on the route, particularly for 10th Ave S
- 10th Ave S is preferred for a bikeway because of its future potential to connect to additional bikeways, it is a direct route for transportation, and has existing traffic calming infrastructure
- Impact to parking availability for residents along E 34th St and 10th Ave S for Powderhorn Park users and visitors
