## One Dead and Two Injured After Shooting

January 11, 2023 (Minneapolis) Minneapolis Police Officers from the 4th Precinct were processing a vehicle crash at Emerson Ave N and Lowry Ave N when they heard multiple gunshots from the 800 block of Lowry Ave at approximately 8:20 pm. Officers responded to the 800 block of Lowry Ave N and identified an adult male with potentially life-threatening gunshot wounds and an adult female with apparent non-life-threatening gunshot wounds seated in an SUV. The SUV was near a parking lot on the 800 block of Lowry Ave N adult male with life-threatening gunshot wounds on Lowry. Officers located a second adult male with life-threatening gunshot wounds on Lowry Ave N across from the parking lot. Officers and EMS provided life-saving measures including CPR. Despite all life-saving measures, the male lying on Lowry Ave died at the scene.

Officers also provided medical aid for the injured male and female seated in the SUV. The injured female was transported by ambulance to HCMC. The injured male who also received CPR was transported by ambulance to North Memorial Medical Center.

Preliminary information indicates that two males on foot approached the male and female seated in the SUV. The first of the males on foot walked around the SUV and to the driver's side door. The driver's side door was opened. The driver drove the SUV in reverse dragging the first male by the driver's open door. At some point, at the least, the second male on foot fired shots. The SUV became stuck in a snowbank. The first male on foot who was drug by the SUV door ran from the parking lot and collapsed on Lowry Ave. A gun was recovered on the street next to the first male. The second male on foot ran from the scene. A gun was also recovered from the SUV.

Forensic scientists from the Minneapolis Police Forensic Division responded to process the scene and collect evidence.

Homicide investigators responded to begin their investigation.

The Hennepin County Medical Examiner will release the identity of the deceased male along with the cause and nature of his death.

No arrests have been made.
