Juvenile Male Dies After Shooting

January 13, 2023 (Minneapolis) At approximately 6:30 p.m., Minneapolis Police Officers from the 4th Precinct responded to the report of a single-vehicle crash on the 4000 block of Dupont Ave N. Officers located a teenage male in the driver seat of a vehicle which was in a snowbank. The teenage male had life-threatening gunshot wounds. Officers attempted lifesaving efforts until relieved by Fire and EMS. Despite all lifesaving efforts, the teenage male died at the scene.

There were two other juvenile occupants. There were no other reported injuries.

The crashed car was a stolen Kia that had been reported stolen from North Minneapolis earlier in the evening.

At approximately 6:24 p.m., 911 reports and Shotspotter activation indicated approximately 14 shots near the 3800 Block of Dupont Ave N. Minneapolis Police believe that the shots fired near the 3800 Block of Dupont Ave N are related to the single-vehicle crash on the 4000 block of Dupont Ave N.

Forensic scientists from the Minneapolis Police Forensic Division responded to process the scene and collect evidence.

Homicide investigators responded to begin their investigation.

The Hennepin County Medical Examiner will release the identity of the deceased male along with the cause and nature of his death.

No arrests have been made.
