Two Adult Males Dead and One Adult Female Injured

February 16, 2023 (Minneapolis) On Wednesday, February 15th, 2023, at approximately 11:35 p.m., Minneapolis Police Officers from the 5th Precinct responded to the report of shots fired on the 2800 block of Colfax Ave S. Officers located an adult male with at least one life-threatening gunshot wound and a female in her 30s with at least one potential life-threatening gunshot wound. The injured male and injured female were seated in a vehicle. The adult male died at the scene. The injured female was transported to Hennepin Healthcare (HCMC).

At approximately 11:40 p.m., Officers from the 5th Precinct were dispatched to the 2800 block of Bryant Ave S on the report of a male down in the hallway of an apartment building. Officers located a male in his late 20s with life-threatening gunshot wounds. Despite all life-saving efforts, that male died at the scene.

Minneapolis Police secured the scenes and canvased the area.

Forensic scientists from the Minneapolis Police Forensic Division responded to process the scenes and collect evidence.

Homicide investigators responded to begin their investigation. Investigators are working to determine if, and or, how, the scene at Bryant Ave S and the scene at Colfax Ave S are related and how any of the involved individuals may be related to the area.

The Hennepin County Medical Examiner will release the identity of each deceased male along with the cause and nature of death.

No arrests have been made.
