Adult Male Dies After Shooting

February 18, 2023 (Minneapolis) At approximately 4:10 a.m., Minneapolis Police Officers from the 4th Precinct responded to the report of a shooting on the 3500 block of Girard Ave N. Officers located an adult male in his 40s with life-threatening gunshot wounds lying in an alley. Officers rendered medical aid until relieved by Minneapolis Fire and EMS. The male was transported by ambulance to North Memorial Medical Center. Despite all life-saving measures, the male died at the hospital.

Preliminary information indicates that the deceased male was working on a vehicle when a second vehicle approached. An argument between the deceased male and an occupant of the second vehicle escalated to gunfire. The second vehicle left the area.

Officers secured the scene and canvased the area.

Forensic scientists from the Minneapolis Police Forensic Division processed the scene and collect evidence.

Homicide investigators responded to begin their investigation.

The Hennepin County Medical Examiner will release the identity of the deceased male along with the cause and nature of his death.

No arrests have been made.
