## American Rescue Plan Act Funding Key Dates

In general, most ARPA dollars are appropriated to City departments to:

- expand programs run by the City
- temporarily add staff, or
- be contracted out to external orgs to achieve a set outcome. This is done following city procurement policies (*often called the "RFP Process"*)

2021

**July 2, 2021**

The City Council approved Mayor Jacob Frey's \$102 million spending plan for the first round of American Rescue Plan Act funding.

2022

**March 24, 2022**

The City Council approved rolling over appropriations from 2021 into 2022 for programs that were making progress and meeting milestones toward completion. Approximately \$8 million of Phase 1 projects were discontinued, making that funding available for repurposing in Phase 2.

**April, 2022**

**Thursday, April 28:** Receive and file of Mayor's ARPA Recommendations and referral to Budget Committee.

**May, 2022**

**10 a.m.-12:30 p.m. Friday, May 6:** Budget Committee Meeting Presentation of the Mayor's Recommendations continued.

**May, 2022**

**10 a.m.-12:30 p.m. Wednesday, May 18:** Markup Meeting #1

**May, 2022**

**Thursday, May 26:** Adoption at City Council meeting, direct to Mayor Jacob Frey for final approval.

2026

**2026**

All ARPA spending must be wrapped up according to current U.S. Treasury Guidelines.

**September-  
November 2021**

The City Council approved a handful of additional ARPA appropriations totaling \$11 million for time sensitive proposals.

**April, 2022**

**1 p.m. Tuesday, April 26:** State of the City address, announcement of Mayor's funding recommendations for ARPA Phase 2.

**May, 2022**

**10 a.m.-12:30 p.m. Wednesday, May 4:** Budget Committee Meeting (*American Rescue Act Plan Review and Presentation of the Mayor's Recommendations*).

**May, 2022**

**6:05 p.m. Thursday, May 12:** Budget Committee public hearing.

**May, 2022**

**If needed: 10 a.m.-12:30 p.m. Friday, May 20:** Markup Meeting #2

**2024**

ARPA funding must be spent on costs incurred by 12/31/2024. Some costs that are properly obligated or encumbered by the end of 2024 may continue to be spent into 2025.
